OAJ members are professionals in the fields of education, training and research, ranging from early childhood education to adult education and training. The Trade Union of Education in Finland OAJ protects the interests of its members. Out of the Finnish trade unions, OAJ is the only one to negotiate teachers' employment terms. Our high unionisation rate guarantees that the union is heard when it comes to education-related decision making. The values of fairness, openness and responsibility direct our operations.

Advocacy is your most important membership benefit. Our network of shop stewards, union operators, occupational safety and health representatives and other specialists supports the members also in difficult situations. There are numerous other membership benefits as well.

The Finnish Trade Union of Education OAJ is the professional organisation for those working in the fields of education, training and research. Together we are more.

We protect your interests

OAJ NEGOTIATES matters related to salary, working hours, and other employment terms of education professionals. OAJ's most important duties include securing and developing employment terms as well as overseeing that the agreed employment terms are adhered to all around Finland.

Collective bargaining advocacy includes supervision of the functionality of the members' pay and working-time systems. We advise and train shop stewards and answer our members' questions. We inform members about the payment of salaries, working hours, study leave or family leave as well as job search and resignation, for instance.

OAJ defends the position of its members in the event of temporary layoffs or cutting down of resources. Without the help of a united, strong and extensive trade union, the employer can easily demand excessive compromises.

OAJ members are supported by their local shop stewards and, if necessary, the experts of labour market advocacy working at the OAJ office. You can find important information related to your work in our 'Pay, conditions & help' section, such as the salary calculator and an employment contract template.

Security in the constantly changing working life

THERE ARE unexpected working-life situations where advice and help are needed. OAJ has industry experts at local, regional and national levels working to protect its members. Reach out to your contact teacher or local association to find out who your shop steward and occupational safety and health representative are. OAJ experts also advise union members regarding their questions.

The employer is responsible for ensuring the health and safety, equality and occupational wellbeing of the personnel's working environment.

The employee, on the other hand, is responsible for notifying their supervisor if they detect any shortcomings in the working conditions or face violent or threatening situations at work. In such an event, it is important to notify your own occupational safety and health representative to receive guidance

Teachers' Unemployment Fund membership is included in the union fee of OAJ. Staff at the Unemployment Fund for Education and Science are experts on the special features of the field of education and training.

If you experience any work-related problems or have any questions, we kindly ask that you first contact your own supervisor. In matters related to the union and memberships, you can contact the contact teacher of your workplace.

Professional legal protection

SHOP STEWARD'S SERVICES, legal aid of OAJ's lawyers and the professional legal protection insurance taken out by OAJ for its members provide its members with significant legal protection.

When a member of the OAJ is in a situation in their employment relationship where they need legal assistance, they can contact OAJ's lawyers using the contact form, by phone or through a shop steward. OAJ's lawyers will investigate the matter and assess whether there are grounds for a legal challenge in the matter and, if so, whether the OAJ's lawyers will handle the challenge or whether the matter will be transferred to an external lawyer with legal expenses insurance.

The professional legal expenses insurance taken out by OAJ for its members is valid if the person has paid the union fee in accordance with the rules of OAJ and has been a member of OAJ for six months prior. The six-month qualifying period does not apply to new members who transfer to OAJ directly from another trade union and who have had equivalent legal expenses insurance in their previous union.

The use of legal expenses insurance requires the support of the union, so members must always first contact OAJ's lawyers.

We influence decision-making in the field of education, training and research

OAJ'S MISSION is to make Finland the best place in the world to teach, learn, and do research. We impact education policies in many different ways in order to make this a reality.

Our education policy advocacy slightly differs from our labour market policy advocacy in that OAJ is not a negotiating party in education policy advocacy but influences decision-making right at the preparation stage. We highlight the concerns and observations of teachers and promote their position when education reforms are being carried out. The voices of our members are important in this work. Through OAJ, the members have their voices heard in the decision-making related to their work.

When Finnish education is developed, many operators often have the same goals, but only OAJ promotes the interests of education professionals. Our reformrelated objectives are for teachers to always have enough resources and to get to keep their jobs. For instance, OAJ has had an influence on the decrees of the Act on Early Childhood Education and Care related to the necessary number of teachers and the competencies required for teachers in the professional reform.

OAJ exerts a significant influence on education policy and is recognised internationally as well. The union's broad member base provides OAJ with notable authority at the decision-making tables.

Due to its responsible advocacy work, OAJ is regarded as a trustworthy operator. This helps our members' voices to be better heard when deciding on matters related to Finnish education, training and research.

Training and occupational information

OAJ organises training training for advocacy shop stewards and teachers at the start of their career: → oaj.fi/en/ membership/oajtrains-and-educates → oaj.fi/en/ membership/oajtrains-and-educates/ nope-training **OAJ'S TRAINING** promotes the advocacyskills of those working in the field and strengthens association activities and the members' own professional identity. The experts of the OAJ office provide training to shop stewards, association chairpersons, occupational safety and health operators, regional operators and those taking part in the operations of OAJ and its associations. Remote training events and webinars are organised more and more often and the selection of training offered directly to members is growing based on the wishes of OAJ members.

Entering working life and starting to work as a teacher is a big change.

OAJ offers the popular NOPE training to those beginning their professional life as a teacher. The training is intended for teachers who have worked in the field for less than five years and are under 35 years of age. The abbreviation 'NOPE' comes from the Finnish words *nuori opettaja* (young teacher). We have provided Uusi ura career training for new vocational education teachers since 2022.

OAJ's member associations organise training for their own employees and members. These local and regional member training events are intended for all members of the associations in question. Training is an important membership benefit.

AS A MEMBER of the union, you are entitled to Turva's travel insurance, luggage and travel liability insurance and are also insured against accidents. Travel insurance also covers accompanying children under the age of 20 (own children and grandchildren, spouse's children and children living permanently in the same household as the insured person) as well as travelling next of kin living permanently in the same household as the insured person. When attending OAJ's events, you are covered by the union insurance against any personal or material damage.

Our members can get a number of holiday and recreational services at an affordable price. The benefits include Holiday Club, various hotel chains and shipping companies and numerous other service providers. Danske Bank offers financial benefits when taking out a mortgage or requiring investing services. OAJ members get discounts from several publishing companies for magazine subscriptions and book purchases.

Your local and regional associations also offer leisure time recreational and event discounts.

As an OAJ member, you have many ways of impacting and improving the position of all teachers: → oaj.fi/sauna → oaj.fi/en/oaj/about → oaj.fi/jasenaloite → oaj.fi/en/oaj/ we-do-good/ **OAJ WANTS** to strengthen and increase participation and interaction. We use surveys to find out the opinions and wishes of our members and to direct our activities in line with the obtained information. The virtual OAJ Sauna on the Howspace platform offers members the opportunity to participate and meet other members, decision-makers and people from OAJ's office as well as to get up-to-date information on topics of interest of different member groups. You can also make member initiatives through Sauna. We recommend that you also actively keep an eye on our communication channels!

The most important decisions at OAJ are made by our members from all around Finland. All teacher groups have their representative in OAJ's Council and Executive Board, for instance. You can best get involved in making an impact by participating in the activities of your association. Active teachers are also needed at the national level. Our goal is to have more teachers to participate in the OAJ Council elections as candidates or voters. An OAJ representative has influence and is at the core of the Council. A member can submit their case to the Council either through an initiative made by a member association or through a member initiative.

OAJ has a global responsibility and works to improve the position of teachers and to strengthen the rights of association operations internationally. We engage in solidarity and development work with Education International in Africa and the Trade Union Solidarity Centre of Finland SASK, for instance. The members of OAJ are welcome to join our network of solidarity work.

Teacher students membership

SOOL takes care of the advocacy of teacher students on a national level and trains and unites future teachers. You can become a member through a member association. If a student cannot join any of the member associations, they can become an individual member.

Apart from unemployment security, the members of SOOL get nearly all of the same national membership benefits as actual OAJ members in addition to the membership benefits of their student association.

You can find more instructions and information related to the student unemployment fund membership, substitute teaching, job search and entering working life on the websites of SOOL and OAJ. A student who has worked as a substitute teacher for at least one term during their studies can become a member of OAJ directly. Once the OAJ membership begins, the membership of SOOL is automatically terminated; however, all the OAJ membership benefits and the potential unemployment fund membership remain valid.

Membership information and union fees

Check that your information is up to date and view your union fee payment status: → oaj.fi/en/ membership/keepyour-membershipdetails-up-to-date/ → oaj.fi/en/ membership/join-theunion/union-fees/ **MAKE SURE** that your information is up to date in the OAJ member register. Information about changes to home address, e-mail address or a change of employer, for instance, are not automatically updated in our membership service, and you need to update them yourself.

Up-to-date information guarantees that you receive our electronic membership letters containing current information about the association and membership benefits. You can log in to the My profile section on our website to ensure that your information is up to date in our register. You can also check that your union fees have been paid.

Your union fee varies according to the membership payment of your own member association and is approximately 1.05 per cent of your gross earnings subject to tax. For instance, you will pay a fixed, lower union fee during parental or study leave.

You should make sure to pay your union fees in time because, for instance, the validity of membership benefits and receiving earnings-related daily allowance requires that you have paid your union fees. If your employer deducts your union fees directly from your salary, make sure to check your payslip to see that the fees have been deducted. If you notice any issues with the union fee payments, make sure to update your payments immediately or contact our membership services.
